

Cricket, Zonta Club, Bacot House Council, International Student Ambassador and school productions to an outstanding role model and leader for Bacot House. To name a few.

Brooke's great love in life is to dance and with her dream career path is heading to a life as a professional dancer. In school she has led many co-curricular dance groups, performed and represented the school to the highest level. This year as her illness returned, never one to let anyone down, her impressive level of commitment was evident as Brooke danced in the production of "Grease". While outside of school,


